

Compass Basics


basic compass parts

TIPS

- Hold the compass level as you swim
- Keep the lubber line in line with the center of your body
- Use a landmark when possible: make note of the bearing in the window for the return course, but swim towards the landmark.
- Count your fin strokes and return with the same number of fin strokes; you should end up where you started.

Bearing Navigation



Point compass in direction you want to go - make note of the bearing in the window



Keep lubber line in line with your body and swim holding the bearing in the window

return course

To find your return course, either add or subtract 180 (If the original bearing is less than 180, add 180. If the original bearing is greater than 180, subtract 180).
